

Site News Updated 29/1/14-----Please Read-- some changes to trailer parking/ racking

Much of the grassed areas at Dorney Lake is still recovering from the Olympic Regatta remedial work, and the recent weather has not helped! So once again, we are forced to operate in a less than ideal fashion. We trust that you will co-operate with us in running a safe and enjoyable event. Even at this stage, the weather is unpredictable, and further changes may be necessary.

The following notes should be read in conjunction with the Circulation diagram.

Site Access

Entry to the site will only be possible from 7:00am on Sunday morning. Please don't arrive before this, and cause the public road to be blocked.

It would be greatly appreciated if as much car sharing as possible could be arranged, since all cars will be parked along the roadside. This will result in some having a fair distance to walk, so please allow for this in your schedule. Car Park operatives will be on site to give directions; even at this stage, plans may change.

Racking and Rigging

Some racking will now be available in the hard standing car park but clubs should bring trestles, as a contingency. The grassed area adjacent to the boathouse reception office is out of use, but the area at the other end of the boathouse is now in use, so boats may be stored here on trestles; there will be no racking.

Toilets

Toilets are available in the crew changing rooms in the boathouse, and additional units are positioned outside, at the "far" (i.e. furthest from the registration bay) end of the boathouse. For those who are disabled, a key to the downstairs unit behind the reception area is available from the paramedic unit.

Turfed and re-seeded ground.

No-one must enter any areas of the site that have been roped off. These are still under recovery and not yet ready for use. Cars or footfall could do significant damage. Please follow any instructions from regatta officials or volunteers or Dorney Staff to avoid damaging these areas. **Competitors should note that the Regatta reserves the right to disqualify competitors who disregard this request or instructions from regatta officials.** All of the above is shown, in diagrammatic form on the Circulation diagrams.
